**EXTSRUCT:\$8.36 12X18:\$15.93 24X36:\$230.10** The description and location of the project is as follows: This project consists of the rehabilitation of the Alfarata Bridge, which carries the traffic of State Route 22 over the Frankstown Branch of the Juniata River. The Alfarata bridge is a five (5) span structure having a reinforced concrete deck and bituminous wearing surface. The superstructure in Span No. 1 is a simple span concrete encased riveted steel multi-girder configuration. The superstructure in Span Nos. 2-5 consists of a four (4) span continuous riveted deck girder-floorbeam-stringer system with overhang brackets. The overall structure length is 720.56 feet. The rehabilitation includes the replacement of the superstructure in span No.1, replacement of deteriorating steel members, replacement of rivets, placing new expansion dams, repair of the concrete abutments and piers, replacement of bearings, cleaning and painting of all steel members, the addition of bridge approach slabs, the widening of the bridge by 2'-0 1/2" (to provide enough width to maintain two lanes of traffic during daylight construction operations), removal and replacement of the bridge deck, and the addition of a concrete barrier to protect the sidewalk. Roadway improvements include milling and resurfacing of the approach roadway and miscellaneous construction, all as indicated on the approved drawings included in the bid package for STATE ROUTE 0022, SECTION 001, in HUNTINGDON COUNTY, MORRIS and PORTER TOWNSHIPS at the following locations: STATION 432+50.00 TO STATION 457+30.00 SEGMENT 0080, OFFSET 1725 TO SEGMENT 0090, OFFSET 1755. DBE 5%, Anticipated Notice to Proceed 12-8-08, Required Completion 11-2-11.
