24X36:\$932.10 The description and location of the project is as follows: for the relocation of SR 2004 (Freedom Road), replacement of an existing bridge over Snake Run, replacement of structures on Romigh Road (T-738 over Crows Run) and Park Quarry Road (T-606 over Crows Run), replacement of a box culvert over Pine Run, relocating Crows Run Stream, reconstruction of Crows Run Road (T-575), relocation of municipal waterline, wetland mitigation and other miscellaneous construction all within a length of 14,270.00 Linear Feet (2.703 Miles) as shown on the approved drawings included in the Bid Package for SR 2004, SECTION B08 and SR 65, SECTION B26. In BEAVER COUNTY, CONWAY BOROUGH AND NEW SEWICKLEY TOWNSHIP. SR 2004 from the intersection with SR 65 at Segment 12, Offset 43 to a point approximately 1000 feet east of the existing SR 2004 intersection with Park Quarry Road (T-606) at Segment 62, Offset 990. SR 65 from a point approximately 3,175 feet south of the intersection with SR 2004 at Segment 140, Offset 3105 to a point approximately 2,475 feet north of SR 2004 at Segment 160, Offset 2565.
