Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:00 A.M., Local Time, on January 30, 2008. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened and read for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. 07-020-RCNS-C – BITUMINOUS OVERLAY OF RAMPS AT WILLOW GROVE INTERCHANGE, M.P. 342.91 AND CONCRETE GLARE SCREEN REPLACEMENT, MP 333 TO MP 351 IN MONTGOMERY AND BUCKS COUNTIES, PENNSYLVANIA

This contract provides for the patching and resurfacing of the Willow Grove Interchange Ramps, inlet replacement, guide rail replacement, painting of traffic lines, bituminous curb replacement and maintenance and protection of traffic. Also included is the replacement of broken sections of the existing concrete glare screen between MP 333 and MP 351.

The Willow Grove Interchange, No. 343 is located at Milepost 342.91; Milepost 333 is located at the Norristown Interchange, No. 333; and Milepost 351 is located at the Philadelphia Interchange, No. 351, in Montgomery and Bucks Counties, Pennsylvania.

Everett, Milepost 154.2, South Side of Turnpike Access from U.S. Route 30 to Black Valley Road, Right onto Ashcom Road.

Bowmansville, Milepost 288.3, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Panorama Drive off PA Route 897.

Plymouth Meeting, Milepost 333.6, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Germantown Pike, East on Plymouth Road.

Pocono, Milepost A-94.7, Access via I-80, Exit 40 and PA Route 940 at Pocono Interchange.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
