NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:00 am, Local Time, on October 1, 2008. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened and read for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. 06-022-RCRN-C – REPLACEMENT OF BRIDGE B-486, MP 204.25 AND ELIMINATION OF BRIDGE B-494, MP 204.91 IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

This project provides for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and work necessary for the replacement of Bridge B-486 at MP 204.25 and the elimination of Bridge B-494 at MP 204.91 over the Pennsylvania Turnpike. The project includes the removal of two rigid frame concrete bridges and the construction of one 2-span continuous composite rolled steel beam bridge. The contract also includes reconstruction and overlaying of T-379, Three Square Hollow Road, reconstruction of maintenance access ramps and a cul-de-sac, drainage modifications, signing and pavement markings and the construction of the mainline median/shoulder at the proposed bridge location.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
