NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:00 AM, Local Time, on November 12, 2008. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened and read for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-010.00R001-3-02 – BITUMINOUS RESURFACING BETWEEN MILEPOST 10.08 AND MILEPOST 19.45 in Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

This Contract provides for resurfacing of the Turnpike roadway between Milepost 10.08 and Milepost 19.45. Work will be accomplished by milling the bituminous pavement down to concrete pavement surface, paving with Superpave binder and wearing courses and installing Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers and Sonic Nap Alert Pattern. Work also includes slab stabilization, replacement of concrete barrier sections, shoulder sealing, median and shoulder inlet repairs and drainage corrections. Also included in this Contract is the maintenance and protection of Turnpike traffic.

Milepost 10.08 is located approximately 0.61 miles east of the New Castle Interchange, No. 10, and Milepost 19.45 is located approximately 8.99 miles west of the Cranberry Interchange, No. 28, in Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

Bowmansville, Milepost 288.3, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Panorama Drive off PA Route 897.

Plymouth Meeting, Milepost 333.6, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Germantown Pike, East on Plymouth Road.

Pocono, Milepost A-94.7, Access via I-80, Exit 273 and PA Route 940 at Pocono Interchange.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
