NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and diskette bids will be received until 1:30 P.M., Local Time, on January 14, 2009. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened and read for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. EN-00049-03-06 – ROADWAY AND MISCELLANEOUS REPAIRS, between Milepost 179.44, the Fort Littleton Interchange, No. 180, and Milepost 241.87, the Harrisburg-West Interchange, No. 242 on the Pennsylvania Turnpike System in Fulton, Huntingdon, Franklin, Cumberland and York Counties, Pennsylvania.

This contract provides for the Commission to issue Work Authorizations to the Contractor to perform roadway repairs as the need arises. The contract time period will extend from the date of Notice to Proceed to April 23, 2010.

Work may include milling existing deteriorated wearing courses, repairing existing deteriorated binder courses, repairing shoulders, applying bituminous wearing course overlays to existing and repaired bituminous surfaces, and performing pavement drainage corrections.

Major work items may include the following items:

- Bituminous Pavement Patching, Various Types
- Superpave Wearing and Binder Courses
- Milling of Bituminous or Cement Concrete Pavement Surfaces
- Pavement Base Drain, Including Shoulder Restoration
- Bituminous Concrete Curb
- Sealing Existing Bituminous Concrete Curb
- Sonic Nap Alert Pattern (SNAP)
- Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers (SRPM)
- Pavement Line Painting

Miscellaneous repairs may include other types of drainage or roadway work that are not associated with the items of work being bid. If the need arises for such work, prices to perform the work will be negotiated with the Contractor for each work authorization.

Quantities will be determined with each Work Authorizations that is issued.

It is understood that the total maximum cost for this contract, to the Commission, may not exceed the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents will be available and open to public inspection December 3, 2008, at the Administration Building. Copies may be purchased upon payment of \$25.00 per set by check or P.O. Money Order (NO CASH) to the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, ATTENTION: SECRETARY-TREASURERS OFFICE, P. O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676. NO REFUND for any reason will be made for plans, specifications and contract documents.

Everett, Milepost 154.2, South Side of Turnpike Access from U.S. Route 30 to Black Valley Road, Right onto Ashcom Road.

Bowmansville, Milepost 288.3, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Panorama Drive off PA Route 897.

Plymouth Meeting, Milepost 333.6, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Germantown Pike, East on Plymouth Road.

Pocono, Milepost A-94.7, Access via I-80, Exit 273 and PA Route 940 at Pocono Interchange.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
