NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:00 A.M., Local Time, on June 17, 2009. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-338.92S001-3-02 - PAINTING OF BRIDGE NO. DB-140A, MILEPOST 338.58 AND COLLISION DAMAGE REPAIRS TO BRIDGE NO. DB-141, MILEPOST 338.92 in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

This contract provides for collision damage repairs of Bridge No. DB-141 at Milepost 338.92 and the painting of Bridge No. DB-140A at Milepost 338.58. The proposed bridge repair work includes heat straightening the lower flange and web of existing girders, zone painting damaged areas and sections of the existing paint system damaged during heat straightening operations, installation of new structural steel strengthening members, and grinding smooth gouged areas of the lower flange cover plates. The proposed bridge painting work includes painting all structural steel and the application of anti-graffiti coating to the exposed concrete.

Major work items include the following approximate amounts:

- LS Maintenance and Protection of Traffic
- LS Structural Steel Repairs
- LS Painting Existing Structural Steel, DB-140A (Approximate 35,000 SF)
- LS Containment
- LS Waste Management
- LS Worker Protection
- LS Heat Straightening Girders
- LS Anti-Graffiti Coating (Approximate 6,900 SF)

This Project is located on the Pennsylvania Turnpike System at Milepost 338.58 and Milepost 338.92, approximately 5.5 miles and 5.8 miles east of the Norristown Interchange, Exit No. 333, respectively, in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

Plymouth Meeting, Milepost 333.6, North Side of Turnpike, Access via Germantown Pike, East on Plymouth Road.

Pocono, Milepost A-94.7, Access via I-80, Exit 273 and PA Route 940 at Pocono Interchange.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
