NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:00 AM, Local Time, on December 1, 2010. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. CONTRACT NO. A-020.00T002-3-05 ROADWAY AND BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION FROM MILEPOST A20.31 TO MILEPOST A25.67 IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The project provides for the staged full depth roadway reconstruction and widening of the Turnpike from 2 lanes in each direction to 3 lanes in each direction and replacement of 7 mainline bridges. The project includes the removal of three single span reinforced concrete bridges, one single span multi-beam bridge, one 3 span steel multi-beam bridge, two 3 span continuous steel multi-girder bridges, construction of two single span composite concrete spread box beam bridges, three single span composite steel multi-girder bridges and two single span composite pre-stressed concrete bulb-tee multi-girder bridges, 1 box culvert extension, 2 arch culvert extensions, 12 retaining walls, 2 soil nail walls, 6 sign structures and the construction of 10 new noise barriers. The contract also provides for signing and pavement markings along the Pennsylvania Turnpike, milling and overlaying of all side roads and drainage modifications.

Milepost A20.31 is located approximately 0.2 miles north of the Mid-County Interchange, Exit 20, and Milepost A25.67 is located approximately 5 miles south of the Lansdale Interchange, Exit 31, in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.

A prebid meeting for this project is scheduled for 10:00 AM, local time, November 9, 2010 at the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission's Eastern Regional Office, telephone (610) 270-1645. The office is located at 251 Flint Hill Road, King of Prussia, PA 19406-2637.

In compliance with the American with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), the Commission had scheduled the meeting at a facility that is accessible to persons having disabilities. Some properties within the project limits may not be in the Commission's possession and entry would require coordinated permission from the legal property owner.
