NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:00 AM, Local Time, on December 22, 2010. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened and read for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-319.30P001-3-02 – CONSTRUCTION OF SR 29 INTERCHANGE, MILEPOST 320.00 IN CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The project provides for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and work necessary to do staged construction for the construction of a four directional interchange and All Electronic Toll Facility having a direct connection to Route 29. The project includes the construction of one single span composite steel plate girder bridge, one 2-span continuous composite steel plate girder bridge, one 4-span continuous composite steel plate girder bridge, one multiple-span continuous composite steel plate girder viaduct, 3 retaining walls, 3 sign structures and two toll plazas including buildings and gantries. The contract also provides for local roadway improvements, utility installations, drainage modifications, signing and pavement markings, roadway lighting and traffic signals.

The project is located on the Pennsylvania Turnpike System in the vicinity of Milepost 320, approximately 6 miles west of the Valley Forge Interchange, Exit No. 326, in Chester County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement of bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.

A prebid meeting under the direction of the Engineer is scheduled for November 30, 2010, at 10:00 AM Local Time, at the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission's Eastern Regional Office, telephone (610) 270-1645. The office is located at 251 Flint Hill Road, King of Prussia, PA 19406-2637.

Prior to any site inspections within Turnpike right-of-way, prospective bidders are required to telephone the Duty Officer at the Operations Center at 866-332-5889 or *11 by cellular and ask for the Duty Officer. Provide the following information:

- brief scope of work
- general timeframe
