Online and diskette bids will be received until 11:30 AM, Local Time, on May 4, 2011. Diskette bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-109.00R001-03-02 – MICRO SURFACING BETWEEN MILEPOST 108.95 AND MILEPOST 121.83 IN SOMERSET COUNTY

This project provides for the micro surfacing of the Turnpike roadway and replacing Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers.

Work items include, but are not limited to:

377,950	SY	Polymer Modified Emulsified Paving System
2,053	EACH	Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers

Milepost 108.95 is located approximately 1 mile west of the Somerset Interchange, No. 110, and Milepost 121.83 is located approximately 12 miles east of the Somerset Interchange, No. 110, in Somerset County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal is published electronically in EBS and is available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
