Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:00 A.M. Local Time, on March 7, 2012. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

**CONTRACT NO. EN-00105-03-08 - BITUMINOUS OVERLAY BETWEEN MP 206.92 AND MP 210.51 IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

This Contract provides for resurfacing of the Turnpike roadway at various locations between Milepost 206.92 and Milepost 210.51. Work will be accomplished by patching and milling the bituminous pavement to a depth of 1½ inches and paving with 1½ inches of Superpave wearing course, installing Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers, line striping and the maintenance and protection of Turnpike traffic. This contract also includes patching, milling and paving work at the Newville Maintenance Building parking area, MP 214.3 Westbound.

Major work items include, but not limited to:

8,176	TON	Superpave Asphalt Material
78,686	SY	Milling of Bituminous Pavement Surface
150	CY	Bituminous Pavement Patching
391	EA	Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers

Milepost 206.92 is located approximately 6 miles east of the Blue Mountain Interchange, Exit 201, and Milepost 210.51 is located approximately 15 miles west of the Carlisle Interchange, Exit 226, in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal is published electronically in EBS and is available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
