Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:00 AM, Local Time, on March 14, 2012. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

**CONTRACT NO. T-102.00R001-03-02 – BITUMINOUS RESURFACING BETWEEN MILEPOST 101.70 AND MILEPOST 108.95 AND SIGN INSTALLATION BETWEEN MILEPOST 99.95 AND MILEPOST 109.00 IN SOMERSET COUNTY**

This project provides for the bituminous resurfacing of the Turnpike roadway. Work will be accomplished by milling and paving the Turnpike roadway with superpave binder and wearing course, and replacing Sonic Nap Alert Patterns and Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers. Work will also include secondary sign installation and maintenance and protection of traffic.

Work items include, but are not limited to:

1,087	SF	Post Mounted Signs, Various Types
1,401	EACH	Snowplowable Raised Pavement Markers (SRPM)

Milepost 99.95 is located approximately 10 miles west of the Somerset Interchange, Exit 110, and Milepost 109.00 is located approximately 1 mile west of the Somerset Interchange, Exit 110, in Somerset County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal is published electronically in EBS and is available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
