This project provides for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and work necessary to install eight (8) completely functional Dynamic Messaging Signs (DMS), and (2) Closed Circuit Television Systems (CCTV) systems.

This project is located between Mileposts 350.2 and 359.0, in Bucks County, New Jersey Turnpike between Mileposts P1.0 and P1.5, SR 132 between Richlieu Road and Reading Ave., US 1 (Lincoln Highway) between Old Lincoln Hwy. and Bristol Rd., and US 13 (Bristol Pike) between Beaver Dam Road and Airport Road. Work is also to be performed within the Turnpike's Traffic Operations Center located at the Turnpike's Administration Building in Highspire, the Trevoise and Delaware Valley Communications Towers, along I-95 near the Pennsylvania Turnpike, and the PennDOT District 6-0 Traffic Management Center in King of Prussia.

Milepost 350.20 is located approximately 1.0 mile west of the Bensalem Interchange, Exit 351, and Milepost 359.00 is located approximately 1.0 mile east of the Delaware Valley Interchange, Exit 358, in Bucks County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%)

percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
