Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:00 a.m., Local Time, on July 11, 2012. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-135.30S001-3-02 - PAINTING OF BRIDGE NO. B-491 AT MILEPOST 135.30 IN BEDFORD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

This Contract provides for the removal of existing paint and the application of a new paint system, application of an anti-graffiti coating to concrete surface of this bridge, and the replacement of protection fencing.

Major work items include the following:

7,323	SF	Painting Existing Structural Steel, B-491
50	SF	Class AA Cement Concrete Repairs
3,112	SF	Anti-graffiti Coating

Milepost 135.30 is located approximately 10.25 miles west of the Bedford Interchange, Exit 146, and 25.50 miles east of the Somerset Interchange in Bedford County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal is published electronically in EBS and is available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
