Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:30 AM, Local Time, on December 19, 2012. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. A-095.00R002-3-02 – BITUMINOUS RESURFACING BETWEEN MILEPOST A-95.17 AND MILEPOST A-105.01 IN LUZERNE AND CARBON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

This project provides for the milling and bituminous overlay of the Turnpike Mainline between Milepost A-95.17 and Milepost A-105.01, deck repair and bituminous overlay of 3 mainline bridges, repair of existing bridge parapets on 2 mainline bridges, replacement of existing bridge parapets on 1 bridge, replacement of structure mounted barrier with structure mounted glare screen on 1 bridge, and abutment repairs on 1 bridge. Included is the maintenance and protection of Turnpike traffic.

Milepost A-95.17 is located approximately 0.2 miles north of the Pocono Interchange, Exit 95, and Milepost A-105.01 is located approximately 0.1 miles south of the Wilkes-Barre Interchange, Exit 115, in Carbon and Luzerne Counties, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
