NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and compact disk bids will be received until the times indicated below on March 20, 2013. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened the following Contracts for Mainline Toll Facility and Delaware River Bridge ORT, MP 351.43 to MP 354.18 and MP 357.96 to MP 358.32 in Bucks County, Pennsylvania:

CONTRACT NO. T-355.00P001-3-07 - GENERAL

1:00P.M., Local Time

The project provides for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and work necessary to do staged construction for the construction of I-276 widening associated with a new toll plaza facility. This project includes the construction of culvert extensions to three existing culverts, one box culvert, two sound barrier walls, one retaining wall, relocation of a channel, one toll plaza including building and gantries, removal of existing Delaware River Bridge toll facilities at I-276 and SR 0013 ramp and the addition of Open Road Tolling at Delaware River Bridge toll to collect one-way westbound bridge tolls. The contract also provides for utility installations, drainage modifications, signing and pavement markings, roadway lighting and traffic signals.

CONTRACT NO. T-355.00P001-3-08 - PLUMBING WORK

1:30P.M., Local Time

All plumbing work within the mainline toll facility utility building, tunnel, and toll booths, including the domestic water system, sanitary waste and vent system, roof drainage systems, fuel oil system, fire protection systems and natural gas system.

CONTRACT NO. T-355.00P001-3-09 - ELECTRICAL WORK

2:00P.M., Local Time

All electrical work within the toll facility building, tunnel, toll booths including highway lighting circuits into the utility building service panel, all conduits and duct banks in tolling areas, E-Z Pass equipment control cabinets, conduits for electrical and data control on E-Z Pass gantries and all electrical work to provide electrical service to the utility building.

CONTRACT NO. T-355.00P001-3-10 - HEATING, VENTILATION & AIR CONDITIONING WORK

2:30P.M., Local Time

All heating, ventilation, and air conditioning work within the mainline toll facility utility building, tunnel, toll booths and the Delaware River Bridge utility building, including HVAC systems for the mainline toll facility and Delaware River Bridge facility, building management system and air intake and air exhaust system, for the emergency generators.

The project is located from MP 351.43, in the vicinity of the Bensalem Interchange, Exit 351, to MP 354.18, approximately 3.5 miles east of the Bensalem Interchange, Exit 351, and at the Delaware Valley Interchange, Exit 358, and the Delaware River Bridge Toll Facility, Exit 359 in Bucks County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on the General Construction (Contract No. T-355.00P001-3-07) only.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement of bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.

A prebid meeting under the direction of the Engineer is scheduled for February 26, 2013, at 10:00 AM Local Time, at the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission's Eastern Regional Office, telephone (610) 270-1645. The office is located at 251 Flint Hill Road, King of Prussia, PA 19406-2637.

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), the Commission has scheduled the meeting at a facility that is accessible to persons having disabilities.
