NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:00 A.M., Local Time, on December 4, 2013. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-122.18F002-3-02 - ELECTRICAL UPGRADES AT THE ALLEGHENY TUNNEL, MILEPOSTS 122.16 AND 123.34, IN SOMERSET COUNTY

This project provides for the replacement of 480/277 Volt main switchboards and lighting inverters at both East and West tunnel portal buildings along with interconnection with the building control system.

Work items include, but are not limited to:

- Removal and replacement of two (2) 480 Volt, 1,200 amp switchboards with integral distribution panelboards and transfer switches.
- Disconnection of power and control circuits and conduits to accommodate switchboard replacement.
- Conduit and circuit extensions to reconnect to new switchboards.
- Reconnection of monitoring and control circuits.
- Connection of existing and new control circuits to Siemens building control system.
- Field coordination with Siemens Building Technologies service group.
- Removal and replacement of four (4) 30kVA UPS systems with (4) 50kVA lighting inverters.
- Removal of UPS split air conditioning systems and replacement with integral units on lighting inverter battery cabinets.
- Core drilling, sleeves and fire seals through walls and floors for conduit.
- Testing of switchgear, components and controls and interface with existing generator system and building controls.
- Temporary power, panelboards, disconnect switches and transformers to limit outage periods.

The Allegheny Tunnel is located approximately 12 miles east of the Somerset Interchange, Exit 110 and approximately 23 miles west of the Bedford Interchange, Exit 146 in Somerset County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract.

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is not a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
