Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:00 am, Local Time, on January 29, 2014. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-099.00T002-3-04 - ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION FROM MILEPOST 99.05 TO MILEPOST 101.79 IN WESTMORELAND AND SOMERSET COUNTIES

This project provides for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and work necessary to perform staged construction for full-depth reconstruction and widening of the Pennsylvania Turnpike from two lanes in each direction to three lanes (in selected areas) in each direction, and for the maintenance and protection of Turnpike traffic. The project will include tie-in of access ramps to the Turnpike and also provides for signing and pavement markings along the Pennsylvania Turnpike.

Milepost 99.05 is located approximately 11.0 miles west of the Somerset Interchange, Exit 110, and Milepost 101.79 is located approximately 8.0 miles west of the Somerset Interchange, Exit 110, in Westmoreland and Somerset Counties, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
