Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11:00 AM, Local Time, on July 9, 2014. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

**CONTRACT NO. T-201.00M001-3-02 - INSTALLATION OF ROADWAY WEATHER INFORMATION SYSTEMS BETWEEN MILEPOSTS 201.0 AND 293.0 IN FRANKLIN, LEBANON AND LANCASTER COUNTIES, PENNSYLVANIA**

This project provides for the furnishing, installation, commissioning, integration, and testing of three (3) Roadway Weather Information Systems (RWIS). The RWIS includes RWIS tower and foundation, weather sensors, Remote Processing Unit (RPU), Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS), and a protective fence. The project also includes work required to establish power and communication to the RWIS sites. The wireless communication system for the RWIS sites will be supplied by the Commission and installed, integrated, and tested by the Contractors. The project also includes training for Commission users and maintainers.

Work items include, but are not limited to:

Milepost 201.0 is located approximately 0.5 miles west of the Blue Mountain Interchange, Exit 201 in Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and Milepost 293.0 is located approximately 5.0 miles west of the Morgantown Interchange, Exit 298, in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
