Online and compact disk bids will be received until 11: 30 AM, Local Time, on April 29, 2015. Compact disk bids will be received by the Contract Management Services Manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, at the Administration Building, Ground Address: 700 South Eisenhower Boulevard, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057 (Mailing Address: P.O. Box 67676 Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-7676). Bids will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

CONTRACT NO. T-330.00M001-3-02 - INSTALLATION OF COMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE MP 330.20 TO MP 333.20 IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY

This project provides for the furnishing and installation of above ground and underground communications infrastructure along the Turnpike mainline. Work also includes maintenance and protection of Turnpike traffic.

Milepost 330.20 is located approximately 2.95 miles west of Norristown Interchange, Exit 333, and Milepost 333.20 is located approximately 0. 10 miles east of the Norristown Interchange, Exit 333 in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission in accordance with Title VI of the U.S. Civil Rights Act of 1964 Parts 21 and 23 of 49 C.F.R. notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that DBE will be afforded full

opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and that no person will be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin in consideration for an award.
