**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Online bids will be received until 11AM, Local Time, on May 12, 2021 and will be publicly opened for the following Contract:

**CONTRACT NO. T-285.27S001-3-02 FOR PAINTING AND REHABILITATION OF FOUR BRIDGES BETWEEN MILEPOST 285.27 AND MILEPOST 295.75 IN LANCASTER AND BERKS COUNTIES**

This project provides for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and work necessary for the painting to four (4) overhead bridges on the Pennsylvania Turnpike. This project also includes class AA cement concrete repairs, aesthetic concrete coating, mill and pave, epoxy overlay, deck repairs, waterproofing membrane, asphaltic plug joint, fiber wrap overhang and right-of-way fence replacement. Work also includes maintenance and protection of traffic.

Major work items include the following:

34,550 SF	Painting Existing Structural Steel
21,860 SF	Aesthetic Concrete Coating – Light Gray
1,740 SF	Aesthetic Concrete Coating – Dark Gray
310 SF	Class AA Cement Concrete Repairs
90 SF	Concrete Bridge Deck Repairs

Milepost 285.27 is located approximately 0.75 miles west of the Reading Interchange, Exit 286, in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and Milepost 295.75 is located approximately 2.25 miles west of the Morgantown Interchange, Exit 298, in Berks County, Pennsylvania.

The proposal and plans are published electronically in EBS and are available to registered business partners for downloading and printing.

An electronic bid bond, from an approved vendor, with corporate surety, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid must be submitted with the proposal as bid security. The bid security of the three (3) low bidders will be retained until the execution of the contract. (The normal time for execution of the contract is approximately four [4] weeks.)

A Prequalification Certification and Applicable Capacity Rating assigned by the Prequalification Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is a necessary prerequisite for bidding on this project.

The opening and listing of bids not meeting all the terms and conditions of the bid advertisement or bid procedures does not act as a waiver or modification of any requirements contained in the bid advertisement or bid procedure.

The Provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended, together with the rates and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Labor and Industry applicable thereto, shall apply to this contract.
